Mission Trip Report

- We raised \$7,500 to help fund a three-story Mission Center. It will house a kitchen and dining area, two barrack-style rooms for sleeping with bathrooms and showers, and a storage area. It will be used as a center for mission groups working in the San Ignacio area as well as a center for camp-meeting type activities.
- We spent close to 1000 man-hours working on the new Mission Center pouring concrete for the footings, moving and laying blocks for the foundation level, moving and leveling dirt for the floor, and pouring concrete for the first floor columns and beams.

- We spent numerous man-hours preparing materials for Vacation Bible School. It was presented to 190 children in the Hillview community of Santa Elena. Our program included singing, stories, drama, puppets, crafts and games.
- We prepared and hosted several hours of live talk radio, aired as “Teen Talk” on *Faith FM*, where our students shared about why they believed in God and how that belief affected their lives.
- We provided clothing, toys, and supplies for the 55 children at the *King’s Children Home*. We also enjoyed spending some time with them presenting Sabbath School, Church, a Sabbath afternoon program, and playing.
- We enjoyed several cultural and recreational activities unique to the country of Belize and neighboring Guatemala.
- We grew closer to God and to each other as we worked together – and as we watched God work in and through us!
