

# *Costa Rica 2004*

## **Mission Trip Report**



- We provided manpower to knock down about 300 feet of concrete fence and dig up the foundation in preparation for building a better fence around a local elementary school.
- We painted a school building (inside and out), sanded and shellacked a number of doors and windows, and painted about 100 cast iron poles to be used in creating the new wall surrounding the school grounds.
- We collected, sorted, and distributed over 2,000 articles of clothing and toys to families in two communities near Tamarindo, Costa Rica.
- We visited with several local families providing food and spiritual fellowship.
- We presented programs of music, crafts, recreation and stories at several elementary schools in the Tamarindo area.
- We helped teach English to several classes of high school students who are preparing to take the necessary tests in order to go to a college here in the United States
- We enjoyed several cultural and recreational activities unique to the country of Costa Rica.
- We grew closer to God and to each other as we worked together – and as we watched God work in and through us!
