- ✚ We gave over 2,000 person-hours of volunteer time in preparing for this trip and serving the people in the Tamarindo area of Costa Rica.
- ✚ We scraped, sanded, treated mold, and painted the music building for the elementary school in Tempaté.
- ✚ At the Ricardo Angulo School in Lagarito, we presented a VBS type program of music, crafts, and stories to the lower grade students; we taught kite science to the upper grade students; and we enjoyed PE with all the grades.
- ✚ We worked with a group of young ladies who for various reasons had dropped out of high school but are now trying to finish their education and work for a better future for them and their families.
- ✚ We collected and delivered clothes and shoes to six needy families who lived in the area surround the Ricardo Angula School.
- ✚ We helped teach English to several young people who are preparing themselves to work in the better paying jobs of the tourist industry.
- ✚ We enjoyed several cultural and recreational activities unique to the Tamarindo area and around the volcano at Arenal.
- ✚ We grew closer to God and to each other as we worked together – and as we watched God work in and through us!
