¹**Math:** All students are required to take a mathematics course in the senior year. If your goal is to obtain a Mathematics Honors Diploma, and you take Algebra I in the 9th grade, you will need to take a mathematics course during the Summer Break, or double up on mathematics courses in the Sophomore year.

²Students pursuing an Honors Diploma will maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.75.

³Dual Enrollment (DE) Credit Courses require a 3.50 GPA admission. Dual Enrollment (DE) Credit Courses: Students earn both High School and College credits. These courses are taught by Florida Hospital College of Health Sciences instructors, on our FLA campus, with admission by GPA.

⁴Electives Options:

(a) Fine Arts

Visual Arts: Ceramics I & II, Digital Photography I & II, Drawing & Painting I & II, Advance Drawing & Painting, Advance Digital Photography, Applied Communications (by instructor approval), Applied Video Communications (by instructor approval), Desktop Publishing, Video Productions, Web Page Design

(b) Physical Education: Swimming, Cross Country Running, Individual Sports & Conditioning
