

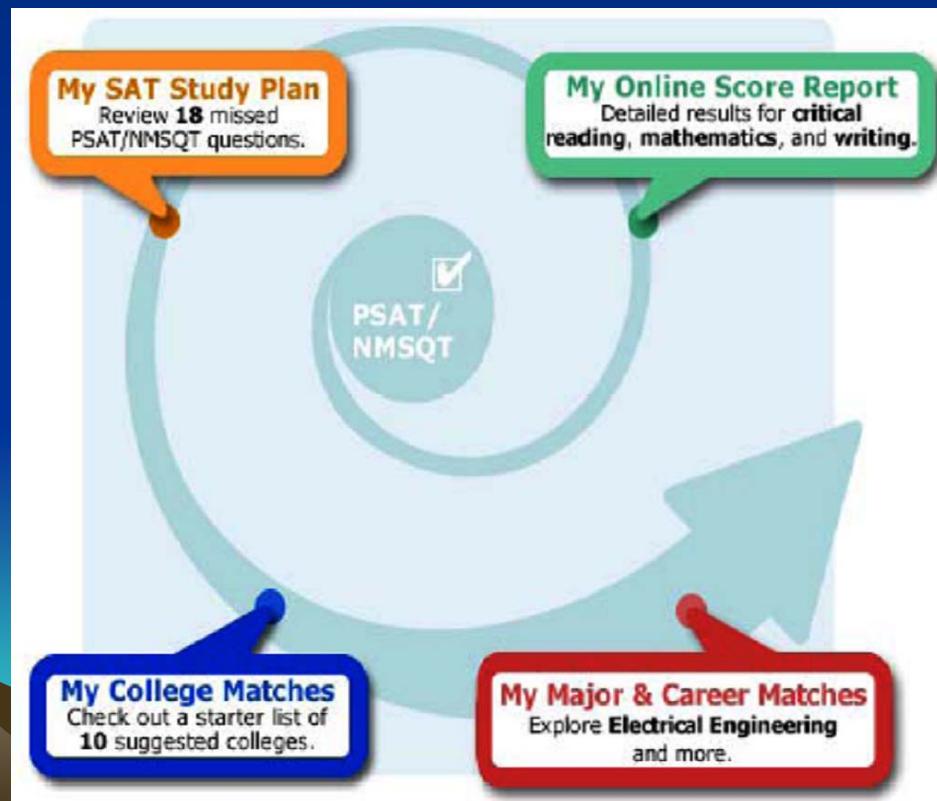

National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) Programs

The 2008 PSAT/NMSQT ® is the official qualifying test for entry to competitions for scholarships to be awarded in 2010. Therefore, students enter the competition by taking the PSAT/NMSQT ® junior year. The PSAT/NMSQT® scores are automatically sent to NMSC. NMSC uses PSAT/NMSQT® Selection Index scores (the sum of critical reading + mathematics + writing skills scores) to determine participants who qualify for program recognition. In April 2009, high-scoring participants from every state will be offered the College Plans Reporting Service. These students will be invited to name two colleges or universities to which they would like to be referred by NMSC. NMSC identifies semifinalists and sends scholarship applications to them.

An asterisk (*) next to the Selection Index means the student's scores will not be used for entry.
