



Objectives for National Honor Society 2009-2010

- Mission:** The members of the Forest Lake Academy chapter of the National Honor Society will uphold the NHS values regarding character, leadership, service, and scholarship.
- Scholarship:** Maintain 3.75 GPA
- Character:** Make an intentional effort to uphold and affirm the behavior and decorum guidelines set by FLA administration
- Leadership:**
1. Actively strive to set a positive tone on campus
 2. Lead through positive example
 3. Take an active role in participating in school activities
- Service:**
- Group:** One group project required each semester. The group project will be determined by vote of the current-year NHS members and will be monitored by the NHS officers and adviser.
- Individual:** Develop an individual project for each semester that is ongoing and extends throughout the semester (may include the whole year). Individual project may include up to four people if all four people make equal significant contribution. Each participant must submit the monthly Individual Project form to the NHS Secretary.

Failure to uphold the objectives will result in the following penalties:

- § NHS members whose GPA drops below 3.75 will be suspended from the organization for the remainder of the grading period. A member with a GPA below 3.75 for two sequential grading periods will be withdrawn from membership.
- § Any NHS member involved in a major discipline situation will be withdrawn; no appeal will be allowed.
- § Any NHS member named in leading out in negative situations (whether suspended or not) will be withdrawn; no appeal will be allowed.
- § Failure to fulfill service requirements will result in withdrawal; no appeal will be allowed.
- § Students must attend NHS meetings; absences must be excused by the adviser.
