DETENTION

Forest Lake Academy will begin implementing detention for students who violate the school's attendance policy. Our policy states that students are to attend all classes and be on time for those classes. Unfortunately some students are experiencing an unacceptable level of truancy which is negatively affecting their academic performance. Poor attendance can also affect their ability to graduate.

Beginning February 14, students who accumulate two unexcused absences will be required to serve detention on the day after the second unexcused absence is received. An unexcused absence from detention will result in a one day suspension from school along with making up the missed detention.

For example, when a student has accumulated two unexcused absences they and their parents will be notified by phone *that day* and detention will be required the following day. If a student reaches two unexcused absences on a Tuesday for instance, then they and their parents would be notified *that day* (Tuesday) and be required to go to detention the next day, on Wednesday evening. If a student's second unexcused absence falls on a Thursday, he or she would serve detention the following Monday evening.

Detention will be served in the Library, Monday - Thursday, from 5:45 - 7:00 P.M. where we will have one of our staff members present.
