Founded in 1926, Forest Lake Academy (FLA) is a college-preparatory Seventh-day Adventist Christian boarding academy for 9th –12th grade students. It is owned and operated by the Florida Conference of Seventh-day Adventists. It is located in Apopka, Florida, a suburb of Orlando. FLA is strengthened from the diversity of cultural and ethnic backgrounds blended together in work, play and everyday life. FLA also has a distant education program (FLA Connect), which classes are taught live, on campus with interactive video sessions everyday between all students and teachers.

ACCREDITATION/MEMBERSHIP

FLA is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools (MSA) and the Commission on Elementary and Secondary Schools (CESS). It is a member of the National Council for Private Schools, CITA – Commission on International and Trans-regional Accreditation, Adventist Accrediting Association, The Florida Conference of Seventh-day Adventist School System, which is an official accrediting body of the Florida Association of Academic Non-public Schools.

ACTIVITIES

FLA participates in the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA). Forest Lake Academy interscholastic athletics program includes Golf, Women’s volleyball, Men and Women’s soccer, basketball. Recreation and Classics are also offered for our students in flag football, soccer, basketball, volleyball, tennis. In addition to Athletics we have: Chapels, Servant Leadership, Praise and worship band, Peer tutoring, Spiritual retreats, Mission trips, Leadership retreats, National Honor Society, Student Government, Senior outbreak, Yearbook, I-TAG, and Senior Play.

DIPLOMAS

Three types of Diplomas are awarded:

- **Honors** 3.75 GPA + Honors Track Courses
- **College Prep**..... 3.0 GPA
- **General** 2.0 GPA

Honor Tracks: Math, Science, Humanities and Health Careers Track – Sophomore year.

DUAL ENROLLMENT CLASSES

FLA partners with Adventist University of Health Sciences to offer seniors with a minimum cumulative 3.50 GPA the opportunity to take college courses for dual credit. There is a discounted tuition fee per credit hour (\$200). There are eight dual enrollment classes offered: Anatomy & Physiology 101&102 (4 hours each) , College English 101&102 (3 hours each), College Statistics (3 hours), College Calculus (3 hours), General Psychology and Developmental Psychology (3 hours each).



PROGRAM OF STUDY

The Academic year is divided into two semesters, each approximately 18 weeks in length. Grades are reported at nine-weeks intervals.
